1	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2	tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled
3	SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
4	This Act may be cited as the "Kangaroo Protection
5	Act of 2024".
6	SEC. 2. KANGAROOS AND KANGAROO PRODUCTS.
7	(a) Definitions.—In this section:

(1) Kangaroo.—The term "kangaroo" means

a dead animal or a part thereof of the species—

9	(2) Kangaroo Product.—The term "kan-

15	purposes, possess with the intent to sell, or sell a
16	kangaroo; or
17	(2) introduce or manufacture for introduction
18	into, sell or offer to sell, trade, advertise, transport,
19	or distribute in interstate commerce a kangaroo

21	(c) Criminal Penalties.—
22	(1) In general.—Any person who knowingly
23	violates this section shall be fined not more than
24	\$10,000, or imprisoned for not more than 1 year, or
25	both.

1	(2) Separate offense.—Each violation of
2	this section shall be a separate offense.
3	(3) LOCATION OF OFFENSE.—A defendant shall
4	be deemed to have committed the offense in the dis-
5	trict in which the defendant may have taken or been
6	in possession of the kangaroo or kangaroo product.
7	(d) REGULATIONS.—The Secretary of Commerce, in
8	consultation with the Attorney General, the Secretary of
9	Agriculture, and the head of any other agency the Sec-
10	retary of Commerce determines appropriate, shall issue
11	regulations necessary to implement this section.
12	(e) Effective Date.—Subsections (a), (b), and (c)
13	shall take effect on the date that is 180 days after the
14	date of the enactment of this section.
